Requirement: Slip Jig or Reel, Treble Jig or Hornpipe, and Set Dance. US must do a Traditional Set Dance. Solo medals will also be awarded for individual rounds. Competitions of less than 5 dancers may be combined. Competitions may also be split based on number of entries.

1	Arizona Roadrunner Feis is registered with and will follow the rules of the North American Feis Commission (NAFC)													
2	Competitors must be in the hall, prepared to dance, one hour prior to the scheduled beginning of their event.													
3	Dancers that appear in competitions in which they are not entered and paid will not be eligible for placement or awards.													
4	When awards are announced from the stage, competitors must be in costume, including dance shoes, to receive their awards.													
5	No videotaping or flash photography of dance competitions is permitted.
